- 1. Minutes of the December 5, 2007 meeting were approved with a correction to add Rich Berg as attending the meeting.
- 2. Update on activities since last meeting:
- a. January 7th convocation with Dr. George Kuh began with a session that addressed the whole campus. Following the plenary session, Departments convened to discuss how to create conditions that matter to student success. These meetings produced various ideas from faculty, specifically on how do we address the engagement piece.

On April 15, our spring Assessment Day, we will have a follow up session with Dr. Kuh's colleague Jillian Kinzie. The purpose of this session will focus more on the first year experience and engaging the first year student.

b. Research on Great Plains institutions
Institutional Researcher, Rod Hair has spent much time on studying institutions in the
Great Plains. The final list of institutions within the Great Plains that are very similar to
Minot State University in several categories consists of 41 institutions.

Additional information on these institutions will need to be collected to provide us with data to produce a list of aspirational peers by several categories. We need to identify those qualities that we want to aspire to and then look at those institutions that have them and see how they got to that point.

- c. Two forums were held in February where priority action plans were discussed.
- 3. Vision 2013 Priority Actions A draft of Vision 2013 Priority Actions was distributed.
- 4. Planning for meetings with individual units
 Meetings with all departments/units are being scheduled between now and the end of the semester to discuss Vision 2013 action plans, the impact on departments, recruitment and evaluations, as well as aligning department/unit planning to Vision 2013.

5. Higher Learning Commission Self-Study and Team Visit
The Higher Learning Commission team of peer evaluators will be on campus March 31 –
April 2. The Planning and Budgeting Council is scheduled to meet with three of the team
members on Tuesday at 2:30 in this room. It will be very helpful for those charter
members of this committee to be available to discuss the history of the committee and
how the strategic planning process has taken place.
